



**MA in Literacy Education: English Education**

For the MA in Literacy Education: English Education, there are 4 required literacy core courses (12 credit hours). There is also a required research course (3 credit hours). With advice and approval from your faculty advisor, you select 5 courses from the SEHD course inventory or CU Denver’s Department of English to personalize your learning (15 credits). For example, you may want to focus on courses that would enhance your background in literature, rhetoric, film; your elementary or secondary teaching and leadership abilities; or your expertise in teaching students of a wide variety of cultures, backgrounds, abilities, and interests.
