PREREQUISITE COURSEWORK FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO COLLEGE OF NURSING <u>AND</u> REQUIRED COURSES AT THE DOWNTOWN DENVER CAMPUS

To take the science courses (listed below under <u>Prerequisite Coursework</u>) required by the University of Colorado College of Nursing you must also take the courses listed here as they are prerequisites for the Downtown Denver Campus:

- Anatomy: Requires General Biology I and II both with labs
- Physiology: Requires General Biology I and II both with labs, General Chemistry I and II both with labs
- Microbiology: Requires General Biology I and II both with labs, General Chemistry I and II both with labs, Genetics and Cell Biology are recommended
- <u>Cell Biology</u>: Requires General Biology I and II both with labs and General Chemistry I and II both with labs
- General Genetics: Requires General Biology I and II both with labs
