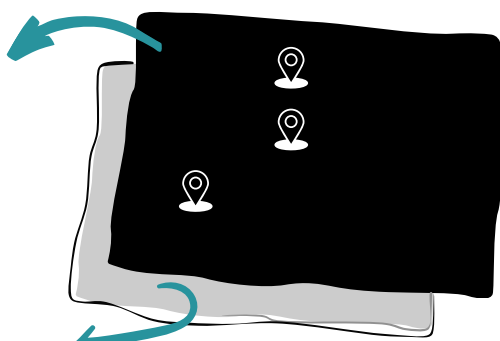
## Participants' characteristics when they joined the study

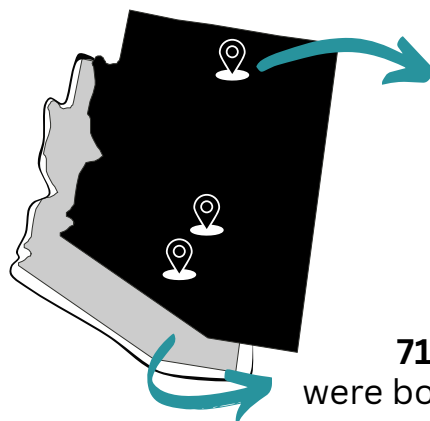

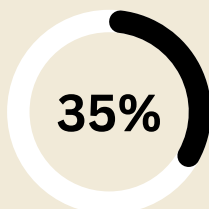

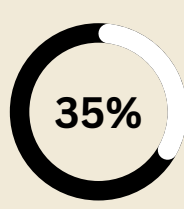

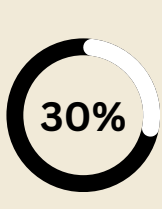

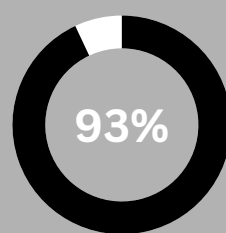

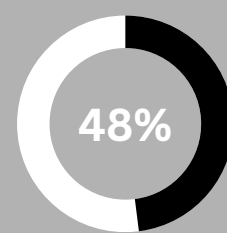
