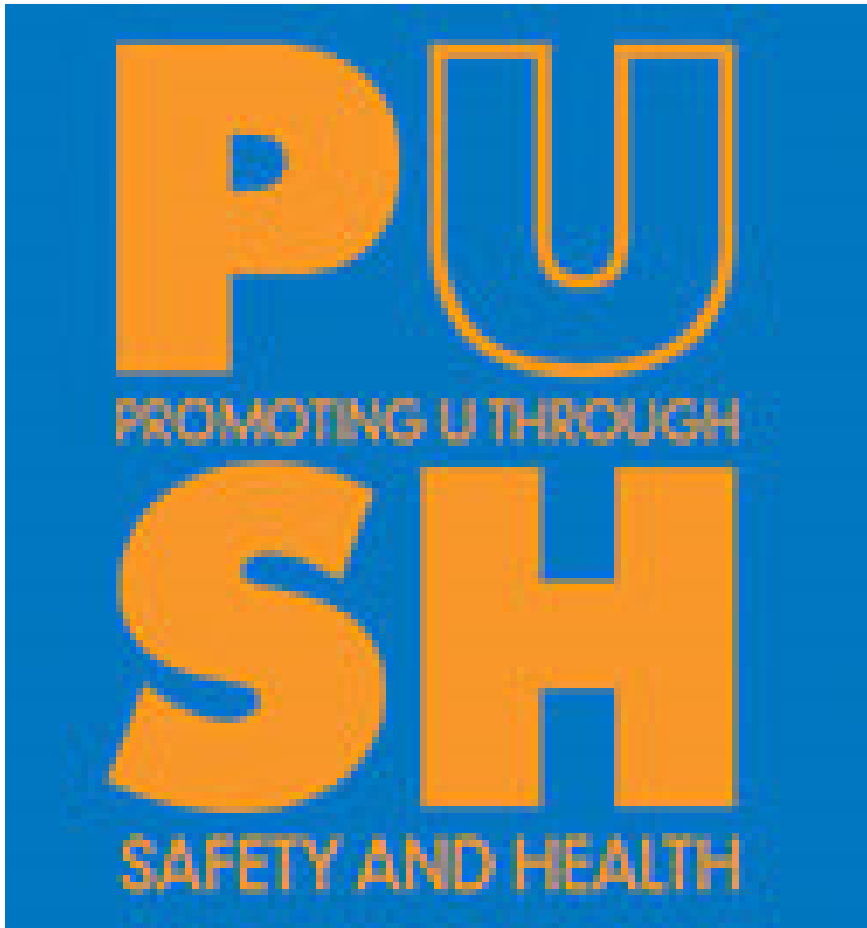

# So, what are the issues for young workers?

- Case definition: Accepted, disabling claims (3 or more work days lost)
- Study period 2003-2012
- Younger worker ages (<25 years) for primary analysis:
  - 14-18
  - 19-21
  - 22-24
- All ages comparison, by decades:
  - Six groups: 14-24, 25-34, 35-44, 45-54, 55-64, 65+ years

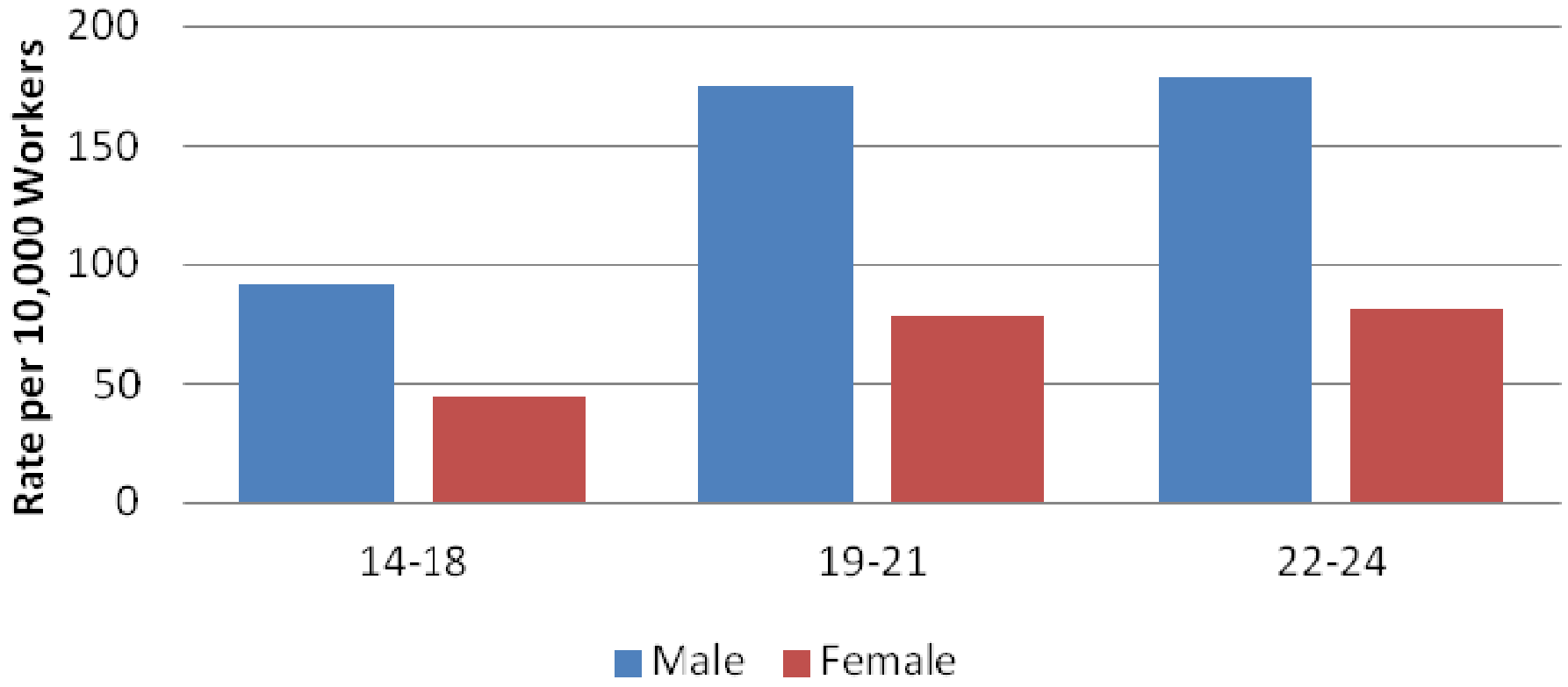
